I attended Blessed Edmund (Edmond?) Campion School in Park Ex from '65 to '69. The school was located on Liege Street between de L'Épée and Bloomfield. Actually the school sat a bit back from Liege as there was a small park in front of the school. The school was demolished in the early to mid 70's (I think) and a 6 storey apartment building built on the former site. The park is still present as is the X pattern path that crisscrossed the park, and which I walked across every day to get to the school.

I do recall a few teachers' names from the time I was at the school (64-69): Principal- Mrs Belair, 1st grade- Mrs Johnson, 2nd grade- Mrs Burns, 3rd grade- Mrs Turgeon and Miss Babyou (spelling?), 4th grade- Miss Dersarkisian (spelling?).
